## 22.1306 Department of Labor notices and reports.

(a) The *contracting officer must* furnish to the contractor appropriate notices for posting when they are prescribed by the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Labor (see <a href="http://www.dol.gov/ofccp/regs/compliance/posters/ofccpost.htm">http://www.dol.gov/ofccp/regs/compliance/posters/ofccpost.htm</a>).

(b) The Act requires contractors and subcontractors to submit a report at least annually to the Secretary of Labor regarding employment of *protected veterans* (*i.e., active duty wartime or campaign badge veterans, Armed Forces service medal veterans, disabled veterans,* and *recently separated veterans,* unless all of the terms of the clause at <u>52.222-35</u>, Equal Opportunity for Veterans, have been waived see <u>22.1305</u>). The contractor and subcontractor *must* file VETS-4212, Federal Contractor Veterans' Employment Report (see "VETS-4212 Federal Contractor Reporting" and "Filing Your VETS-4212 Report" at <u>http://www.dol.gov/vets/vets4212.htm</u>).
