## 47.205 Availability of term contracts and basic ordering agreements for transportation or for transportation-related services.

- (a) All Government agencies *may* contract for transportation or for transportation-related services and execute basic ordering agreements (BOA's) (see <a href="subpart 16.7">subpart 16.7</a>) unless agency regulations prescribe otherwise. However, it is generally more economical and efficient for most agencies to make use of term contracts and basic ordering agreements that have been executed by agencies that employ personnel experienced in *contracting* for transportation or for transportation-related services. The Department of Defense (DoD) and the General Services Administration (GSA) contract for transportation or for transportation-related services on behalf of other activities and agencies. For instance, GSA awards term contracts for services such as local drayage, office moves, and ocean-*freight* forwarding (see <a href="47.105">47.105</a> for assistance).
- (b) Agencies *may* obtain transportation or transportation-related services for which the cost does not exceed the *simplified acquisition threshold* if term contracts or basic ordering agreements are not available.
