## 252.217-7026 Identification of Sources of Supply.

As prescribed in 217.7303, use the following provision:

## IDENTIFICATION OF SOURCES OF SUPPLY (JAN 2023)

- (a) The Government is required under 10 U.S.C. 4753 to obtain certain information on the actual manufacturer or sources of supplies it acquires.
- (b) The apparently successful Offeror agrees to complete and submit the following table before award:

- (4) For items of supply, list all sources. For technical data, list the source.
- (5) For items of supply, list each source's part number for the item.
- (6) Use "Y" if the source of supply is the actual manufacturer; "N" if it is not; and "U" if unknown.
