542.1502-70 Internal acquisition policy, procedure, and guidance.

Heads of Contracting Activities (HCAs), consistent with their delegated authority (see $\underline{501.601}$ (b)(2) and $\underline{501.370}$ (b)) may establish internal acquisition policies, procedures, and guidance for their respective contracting activity(ies) concerning the collection and maintenance of contractor performance information and integrity information as required by FAR $\underline{\text{subpart } 42.15}$ and this subpart. The internal acquisition policy, procedure, and guidance shall include:

- (1) If applicable, requirements for reporting contractor performance evaluations for classified contracts and special access programs (see FAR42.1503(f)).
- (2)If applicable, requirements for providing interim contractor performance evaluations (see FAR 42.1503(a)(3)).
- (3)Identifying and assigning contractor performance evaluation roles and responsibilities, such as identifying and assigning reviewing officials and their responsibility (e.g., reviewing disagreements regarding contractor performance evaluation). See FAR $\underline{42.1503}$ (d) and 542.1570-5.
