Welcome to your FAN in a Minute!

- Part A: <u>FAR Case 2015-022</u>, Unique Identification of Entities Receiving Federal Awards

The phrase "DUNS number" is being replaced in the FAR by "unique entity identifier."

The Government is exploring alternatives to the existing entity identifier.

So, while DUNS is still being used in practice, going forward, Contracting Officers should use the term "unique entity identifier" instead of "DUNS."

- Part B: FAR Case 2014-015, Consolidation and Bundling

Are you planning to conduct a consolidated acquisition exceeding 2 million dollars? Be aware that the FAR requires the Senior Procurement Executive OR Chief Acquisition Officer to determine in writing that it is necessary and justified.

- Part C: Subpart 22.8 – Equal Employment Opportunity

Did you know that:

FAR 22.8 prohibits contractors from discriminating against employees and job applicants because they have asked about, discussed, or disclosed their own or another's compensation.
